o fixdist.support.apple.com (130.43.6.8)

This is the Apple ftp server that provides analogous software support to IBM's fixdist server. It includes the fixdist application and regular postings of new AIX 4.1.x fixes qualified by Apple for use on the Apple Network Servers. A README in the root directory provides instructions on how to download and use the fixdist application.

o ftp.support.apple.com

This ftp server is a mirror for Apple Software Updates, but also includes UNIX-specific content not available at other Apple sites. For miscellaneous AIX fixes such as the Hooked Symbols package required for installation of Netscape Products or the Ping of Death fix, use the path:

/pub/apple_sw_updates/US/unix/AIX/supported/4.1.
